Shell & Plate Heat Exchangers FP SP

FUNKE as specialist for shell-and-tube as well as plate heat exchangers has combined the advantages of these two designs in one - with the FP SP heat exchangers FUNKE presents a new generation.

Main components of these heat exchangers are a pack of welded circular plates and a shell enclosing this plate core.

The result are very large heat exchanging areas with little need for place and low weight.

With their compact and gasket-free design the FP SP are suited for applications with high temperatures and/or high pressures with a concurrently very good heat exchange ratio.

The circular heat exchanging plates promote an improved distribution of tensions caused by differences in pressure or temperature. The plates are available with different profiles, with one plate laid on top of another turbulence-optimized channels are created for the two operating media. The media can be guided in countercurrent, cross-flow or co-current.

The plates are welded by laser with low heat input resulting in a large connection area. The low heat input prevent from structural changes during cooling down. Due to laser welding there is only little vulnerability to corrosion of the weld seam, protection against leakage generally augments.

The FUNKE shell & plate heat exchangers are available with openings on one or two sides, both with removable plate pack.






